"DISCOUNTS OR NO DISCOUNTS"

While we encourage all vendors to have sales and special discounts, the proper procedure to do so is to apply that discounted price to each item. This can be achieved two ways: (1) if you have labels through the vendor portal, you can access your account and adjust prices in the systems. The price change will reflect on the already printed labels when the item is rang up. Or (2) If you have handwritten tags, you will have to handwrite the discounted amount on the tag. This will communicate with the front end staff on how to ring up your merchandise. Be mindful though. If you only put up a sign stating a discount, but fail to discount your merchandise, the discount will not be recognized and most likely the sign will be removed.
